**Historical Note:** 

Lester Stowers Sr. was born on February 16, 1917, in Salter River Township in Audrain County, Missouri, to John Harrison Stowers and Rose Ellen Scott Stowers and had two siblings. He enlisted in the United States Army on June 21, 1941, and was discharged on August 16, 1945.

He married Francis Lucille Tratchel in 1945. Lucille was a school teacher in the Audrain County rural school district for 49 years and received her bachelor's degree from Kirksville State Teacher College in 1943 and her master's degree from the University of Missouri-Columbia in 1974.

Lester Stowers Sr. passed away on January 3, 2008, in Mexico, Missouri.

#### **Scope and Content Note:**

### Correspondence

Stowers' correspondence consists of handwritten letters to his future wife, Frances Lucille Tratchel, during his service in World War II. Most of the information contained in these letters consists of daily life updates from Lester to Lucille, who he married in July 1945. While Lester is the author for most of the correspondence, Francis (who went by Lucille) becomes the primary author starting from April 1945.

As part of the 160<sup>th</sup> Infantry Regiment of the 40<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division of the United States Army, he was primarily stationed in California, Washington, Hawaii, and Guadalcanal. Lester never wrote in detail about any significant movements during his tenure in the Army but notes that others he met during training were involved in unnamed operations based in Australia.

### **Photographs:**

The photographs included within this collection pertain to Stowers' life at camp during his training period. Most of the photos are unlabeled, though some photos have handwritten notes on the back. Most of the photos are of people Lester was with and the training they took part in which appeared to be based in a tropical location. Other photos include individuals in traditional Hawaiian dress as well as those of a United Services Organization (USO) show taking place within a theater. The collection also includes a panoramic regiment photo of the 160<sup>th</sup> Infantry Regiment when they were stationed at Fort Lewis in Washington State near Tacoma.
