Historical Note:

Dan B. Hoagland was born in Brookfield to Roy Hoagland and Charlotte Cary on January 1, 1922. He served in the U.S. military during World War II and attended college at the University of Cincinnati and University of Missouri, earning a Bachelor of Science in Education in 1949. On October 6, 1967, he married Janette Rogers and became stepfather to her three children. He died 19 years later on October 6, 1986.

Hoagland was a career professor and held teaching positions at Trenton Junior College, University of Missouri, and Central College in Fayette. While a correspondence instructor of mathematics at University of Missouri in the early 1950s, he was also a violinist with the University Orchestra and composed a number of marches for the Mizzou concert band. He also held a faculty position as a professor of mathematics and astronomy at Columbia College from 1958 until his retirement due to illness in 1985. During his tenure, he contributed to the creation of Columbia College's first honors program.

Arrangement:

The collection has been arranged alphabetically by record type.

Scope and Content Note:

This collection contains materials related to Dan Hoagland's work as a Missouri composer, including several compositional scores, a notebook of musical notation, a notebook of verse, and an audio tape recording of "The Norseman" as performed by the Hickman High School Band on May 11, 1970. The paper materials are undated.
