The mission of Epsilon Sigma Phi is to foster standards of excellence in the Extension System and develop the Extension profession and professionals. Membership is not restricted to students, extending to include administrators and professionals of all levels. The Alpha Tau chapter was organized at the University of Missouri-Columbia in 1962.
