Abstract: Papers of two University of Missouri-Columbia alumni, United States veterans, and federal employees. Mrs. Hutchison was in the first class of WAVES officers at the start of World War II, and later a CIA staff officer for twenty-five years. Includes a scrapbook related to theater and other activities at the University of Missouri in the 1930s, correspondence, diaries, photographs, travel materials, writings, and miscellaneous items.

Historical Note:

Mary Elizabeth Folse was born October 3, 1911, in Kansas City, Missouri. She was the eldest child of Belle Lena Stewart and Charles Druzin Folse, followed by two sisters, Lucille and Ruth, and a brother, Dean. She attended Kansas City's Westport High School, graduating in 1928, and had a keen interest in theatre and writing poetry, which continued throughout her life. From 1928 to 1934, Mary attended the University of Missouri, where she earned bachelors, masters, and doctorate degrees in archaeology and met Gregory Hutchison, her future husband.

While at university, Mary was a member of the Women's Student Government Association, Athenaeum Literary Society, Sigma Epsilon Sigma freshman scholastic society, Student Interscholastic Committee, Archaeological Society of Missouri, German Club, the Tigerettes pep organization, YWCA, and classical languages fraternity, Eta Sigma Phi-Alpha Mu chapter. After graduation, Mary attended a year of studies abroad at the American School of Classical Studies in Athens, Greece, where she participated in excavations at the site of the ancient city of Corinth. Returning to Missouri, Mary oversaw the renovation and reopening of Mizzou's Museum of Classical Archaeology and Arts in Jesse Hall in 1937. Later, she moved to Houston, Texas, and worked as a public school teacher until receiving an ensign commission with the US Navy Reserves in September 1942.

Mary was a member of the first class of WAVES officers during World War II, where her fluency in English, Spanish, German, Greek, and French, earned her the sole WAVES-held position as an ambassador to foreign officials, servicemembers, and travelers in the country. Stationed at the naval base in Miami, Florida, Mary – now Lieutenant Mary Folse Hutchison – greeted, coordinated, and entertained foreign visitors and their entourages from November 1942 through 1946. In addition to this work, Hutchison assisted with debriefing Jewish and German refugees.

After the end of the war, Hutchison continued her service with the Navy Reserve, retiring at the rank of Lieutenant Commander. She joined the Strategic Services Unit (SSU) in 1946 in order to follow her husband's SSU assignment to Germany. During her initial interview with CIA Director Richard Helms, Mary protested his offer of a secretarial job as a waste of her talents, negotiating up to secure herself a position as the CIA's first female reports officer. In 1953, she served alongside twelve other female CIA officers on the Career Service Board Panel on Women in CIA – colloquially “the Petticoat Panel” – a task force on gender inequality and pay disparity within the Agency. Despite her credentials, high-value skills, and recommendations by commanding officers, Mary's ability to rise in rank and pay were stymied by both her sex and her status as the spouse of another CIA staff officer, resulting in a slow track of promotions until her last in 1955, a full fifteen years before she retired from the organization.

Gregory Lewis Hutchison was born July 4, 1910, in Norman, Oklahoma. His parents were Lon Lewis Hutchison – a geologist and oil company owner - and Jessie Pennington. He had one younger sister, Mary Genevieve. Gregory grew up in Tulsa and participated in ROTC, receiving a cadet commission as Captain in November 1929. He moved to Columbia, Missouri, to attend the University of Missouri, from which he received his bachelor's degree in Journalism in 1932 and a master's degree in English in 1939. After graduation, he returned to Tulsa to teach and serve with the US Department of the Interior, Board of Education. He married fellow Mizzou graduate, Mary Folse, in New Orleans, Louisiana, on March 12, 1943.

Gregory was drafted into the US Army in 1943 to serve in World War II, switching to the Strategic Services Unit (SSU) after the war's end. After completing Officer Candidate School in 1945, he was stationed as a first lieutenant in Germany. In 1946, he enlisted in the Army Reserves at the rank of captain and served as adjutant for the SSU in Germany. Following the formal establishment of the CIA in 1947, Hutchison worked in administration and liaison affairs in Washington D.C., Korea, Japan, and Germany. He attended the United Forces Staff College in 1953, resulting in his eventual promotion to chief of the Regulations Control Staff, which first codified CIA regulations. Greg retired from the Army Reserves at the rank of Lieutenant Colonel in 1970.

During their careers with the Central Intelligence Agency and its predecessors, the Hutchisons received a number of overseas assignments. Originally operating out of CIA headquarters in Washington D.C. from the organization's inception in 1947, the Hutchisons were assigned to Japan in 1949. They commuted from Kamakura at first, later relocating to Tokyo to shorten their commute to the Far East station office and their cover jobs, including Mary's job as a secretary for the Asiatic Society. This assignment lasted until 1952, whereupon they returned to Washington. From 1957 to 1962, Greg and Mary were assigned to Frankfurt, Germany, where Greg served as war plans officer for the German Intelligence Committee Working Group. The Hutchisons again returned to Washington, establishing residence there for the rest of their lives, including their final years as residents of Knollwood, a retirement community for veterans.

Greg and Mary Hutchison established and endowed the L. L. Hutchison Memorial Fellowship Fund for Geology and Geophysics at Yale University, where Lon Hutchison earned his graduate degree in 1908. They also donated funds to the Charles D. Folse Fellowship for ancient mediterranean archaeology graduate studies at the University of Missouri-Columbia, in honor of Mary's father.

Mary Folse Hutchison died in 2007, followed by Gregory Lewis Hutchison in 2013. They are interred together at Arlington National Cemetery.

Scope and Content Note:

Art

This series contains drawings, sketches, and doodles by Mary, including portraiture and miscellaneous scenes, as well as scrapbooks of artwork she collected, 1930s-1970s, undated.

Correspondence

This series consists of letters between Mary, Greg, Folse and Hutchison family members, friends, fellow servicemembers, CIA associates, and citizens of foreign nations for whom Mary Hutchison provided liaison services during their visits to the United States, 1918-2013.

Diaries

This series consists of diaries kept by Mary and Greg, 1924-1952, and travel journals recorded over the course of their vacations, trips, and overseas government assignments, 1950-1993, 2003.

Folse Family

This series contains the personal papers of a young Mary Folse and her sisters, parents, and other extended family members, including correspondence, business paperwork, and genealogical research on the Folse and Stewart families, 1882, 1908-1993, undated. Also included are reminiscences recorded by Mary as part of an unfinished autobiographical project in the 1990s.

Household Papers

This series consists of materials pertaining to the economics and everyday business of the Hutchison household, including inventories of household items and furniture, financial records, address books, and property records, 1940s-2000s.

Hutchison Family

This series contains the personal papers of Lon Hutchison, materials created or compiled by Greg in his youth, and miscellaneous papers of the extended Hutchison family, including correspondence, photographs, and a series of cookbooks.

Military

This series consists of materials pertaining to Mary's WAVES and other United States Naval Reserve career and George's service with the United States Army and Army Reserve, including official paperwork, reminiscences, photographs, letters, travel information, and press, 1942-1970. Additional records pertaining to life during military and CIA assignments can be found in the **Household Papers**, **Travel**, and **Writings** series.

Photographs

This series consists of photographs of Greg and Mary, members of the Folse and Hutchison families, and associated friends and colleagues. Additional photographs can be found in the **Travel** series and, to a lesser extent, throughout the entirety of the collection.

Travel

This series consists of records documenting overseas assignments and recreational trips taken across Europe, the Americas, the Pacific, and Asia, including planning documents, financial records, photo albums, travel diaries, event records, and correspondence, 1939-2000s. Additional travel records can be found in the **Diaries** series.

University of Missouri

This series consists of materials pertaining to Mary and George's respective years in college, including school notes and papers, event programs, press, certificates, administrative files, and other materials, 1928-1939. Also included are a scrapbook of university theatre records and files related to financial and material donations to the University of Missouri, 1985-2007.

Writings

This series consists of poetry, prose, reminiscences, and miscellaneous notes written by either Mary or Greg, 1920s-2010. Many of these items are untitled, undated, or incomplete, and as such, they are arranged primarily by type. Additional writings can be found in the **Diaries**, **Folse Family**, and **University of Missouri** series.

Oversize Materials

This series consists of Greg Hutchison's loose diary pages, diplomas, and military commissions, as well as various certificates for both Mary and Greg, 1924-1983, undated.

Oversize Volumes

This series consists of one scrapbook of photos, news clippings, event programs, and ephemera compiled by Greg Hutchison, 1921-1925.
