The collection consists of a single scrapbook volume containing photographs and items related to the birth and early life of Betty Mae Gilpin Roark Weithers.

Betty Mae Gilpin Roark Weithers was born on February 15, 1927, in Kansas City, Missouri, to Fred P. and Olga Irene North Gilpin. After graduating from the Southwest High School in Kansas City, Missouri, Weithers attended the Kansas University and earned various degrees in education. In 1967, she joined the Kansas State Board of Education and became the director of the special education department in 1990. She was awarded the Outstanding Special Education Administrator Award by the Kansas Association of Special Education Administrators in 1982. Weithers served on numerous educational state and national committees and boards. She died on December 5, 1994, in Kansas City, Missouri, and is buried at Mount Moriah Cemetery in Kansas City, Missouri.
