**Abstract:** The Congregation Beth Shalom VHS Collection contains eight cubic feet of VHS videotapes, primarily focused on the lectures of Rabbi Morris Margolies. Rabbi Margolies was Beth Shalom's senior rabbi from 1961 to 1986 and continued his involvement with the congregation until his death in 2012.

### **Historical Note:**

Congregation Beth Shalom is a conservative Jewish community that strives to enhance congregants' life-long connections to Judaism. The congregation traces its roots to Congregation Keneseth Israel, which originated in 1878 from Russian and Polish immigrants who had formed their own burial society and built its first synagogue in 1902. Congregation Beth Shalom was formed in 1915 when a group of congregants separated from Congregation Keneseth. In 2022, the congregation consolidated with Congregation Ohev Sholom, another leading conservative congregation in Greater Kansas City. The congregation's current location is at 14200 Lamar Avenue in Overland Park, Kansas.

A leading figure in Kansas City's Jewish community, Rabbi Morris Margolies (1921-2012) joined Congregation Beth Shalom as senior rabbi in 1961. Although he officially retired in 1986, he continued to serve the congregation in a variety of capacities until his death in 2012. His lecture series at Beth Shalom regularly drew hundreds of listeners.

### **Arrangement:**

The tapes are arranged in their original numerical order. Tapes 39, 71-73, 86, 91, 102, 119, and 161-164 were not donated.

### **Scope and Content Note:**

The collection consists of VHS tapes recorded between 1985 and 1996. The tapes contain a variety of sermons and lectures delivered to members of Congregation Beth Shalom. Several of the tapes feature Rabbi Morris Margolies.
