Biographical Note:

John Alexander Happel, a farmer in Dent County, was born in Phelps County, Missouri, on May 16, 1879. He married Eva Pearl Malone (1888-1963). They had five sons: Lloyd, Lawrence, Carl, John, and Marion Happel. The couple was well known in both Phelps and Dent counties and frequently appeared in the society pages of local newspapers. John A. Happel died in 1936, when his son John E. Happel (1926-2020) was only ten years old. The bulk of this collection consists of photographs documenting John E. Happel's travels, passions, and everyday life in Rolla, Missouri. The collection also includes family photographs of both the Happel and Wills families, collected by Happel and his wife throughout their lives.

John E. Happel attended John F. Hodge High School in St. James, Missouri, and the University of Missouri at Columbia. He was drafted into the United States Army in October 1944 and served in the Pacific theater. He joined as a paratrooper with the 11th Airborne Division and fought in the Battle of Luzon, P.I., in April 1945. He is credited with nine jumps and was awarded a Good Conduct Medal for "faithful and exact performance of duty." After the war, John returned to Missouri to be near his family.

In 1951, John began working in Rolla at the Holsum Bakery. He worked there for 32 years until the plant closed in 1983. The Holsum bakery was a top-of-the-line bread manufacturing company that originated in Springfield and branched out into satellite factories in the surrounding areas. In 1952, it employed 77 men and had the capacity to bake and deliver 2,000 loaves of bread per day. In the summer of 1960, John E. married Bonnie Lee Wills, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Cecil Wills. The Wills family also lived in Dent County, not far from the Happel family farm in Seaton. Bonnie attended Salem High School, and, at the time of her marriage, she was employed by the Missouri Geological Survey in Rolla, Missouri. The couple decided to settle in Rolla, Missouri, where they lived until their deaths.

John E. Happel loved taking photographs of and with country music stars in the 1960s and the 1970s. He traveled across Missouri and Tennessee to see his favorite artist perform live concerts at various venues, including the opening show at the Grand Ole Opry in Nashville. He also loved Cardinals baseball and would often travel with his wife Bonnie to see games and Busch Stadium in St. Louis, Missouri. John and Bonnie had no children, though they raised beagle hounds. The couple was active in the Rolla community and had many close friends there. John E. Happel died in December of 2020 at the age of 94, leaving behind his wife Bonnie and many nieces and nephews in the area.

Scope and Content Note:

Personal Papers

This series contains materials related to the personal lives of certain members of the Happel family. These items are limited in scope but include newspaper clippings, certificates and awards, and correspondence found among the assortment of photographs that make up the bulk of this collection. The personal papers series is arranged by family member.

Photographs

This series includes photographs of the Happel and Wills extended family, personal photos of John with his wife Bonnie, and home life photos, particularly around the holidays. It also includes travel photos, images of the Happel family farm in Dent County, Missouri, baseball photos from across the state, and pictures of famous country music stars from the 1970s. The photograph series has been arranged by theme.

Post Cards

This series contains materials related to the travels of John and Bonnie Happel. They picked up postcards along the way and kept them as souvenirs. Most of the postcards in this series are from tourist areas in Wyoming near the Grand Tetons. The postcard series is arranged by location.

Miscellaneous

The largest section of miscellaneous documentation found in this series is an entire folder of the personal papers of Isom and Ona Cox. Isom Cox was a postman in Salem, Missouri, for many years, starting before the turn of the century and delivering mail on horseback for the first half of his career; his wife, Ona, was a teacher.

This series also contains random materials that the Happel family collected over the years, including a Phelps Health newsletter and information about the Scott Cemetery on the Happel farm in Seaton, Dent County, Missouri. It also contains information about the Alamo Christian Ministries, a selection of general notecards, comics, and maps. This series was arranged by its relationship with local history interests.

Obituary Cards

This series contains funeral programs from funerals that the Happel's attended over the years. They are arranged alphabetically by surname.

Oversize

This series contains materials related to the Phelps County Centennial celebration held in 1957 and Mr. Isom Cox. There is also one photograph of Bonnie Lee Wills Happel. This series is arranged by size.
