Abstract: The John F. Bradbury, Jr. Papers contain Bradbury's research files pertaining to Missouri history and his various publications. Research subjects include the American Civil War in Missouri, Route 66, Missouri railroads, rivers and resorts, the Missouri Ozarks, and the lumber industry. The extensive Civil War research focuses primarily on southern Missouri that he used for his many publications, including his books, *A History of Southern Missouri and Northern Arkansas: Being an Account of the Early Settlements, the Civil War, the Ku-Klux, and Times of Peace* and "My Own Commander:" *The Civil War Journal of J. J. Sitton, 1863-1865*.

Historical Note:

John F. Bradbury, Jr. was born on October 24, 1952, in Heidelberg, Germany, to John F. and Jeanne (Holcomb) Bradbury. His father was serving as a Lieutenant Colonel in the United States Army. Soon after the family moved to Missouri where Bradbury, Sr. was stationed at Fort Leonard Wood and worked as an ROTC instructor at the Missouri School of Mines (now Missouri University of Science and Technology).

Bradbury attended school at the University of Missouri – Rolla, (now Missouri University of Science and Technology) where he received his bachelor’s degree in history in 1974. He attended a year of graduate school at the University of Wyoming-Laramie before leaving to take a job with the Union Pacific Railroad, working as a section man and section foreman.

Bradbury started working for the Western Historical Manuscript Collection at its Rolla Research Center in 1980 as a Manuscript Specialist. By the end of his career, he was the Associate Director, a position he held until his retirement in 2015. He was then appointed Senior Fellow by the State Historical Society of Missouri and continued work on research projects. His list of publications includes numerous articles in the *Phelps County Historical Society Newsletter* and the *Missouri Historical Review*. He also co-authored or edited *A History of Southern Missouri and Northern Arkansas: Being an Account of the Early Settlements, the Civil War, the Ku-Klux, and Times of Peace*; *Old Pulaski in Pictures: Rivers, Rails, Roads, and Recreation, Pulaski County, Missouri*; *Rolla: The Old Town*; and *Route 66 East to West: A Self-Guided Tour Through Phelps County*. His final work “*My Own Commander: The Civil War Journal of J. J. Sitton, 1863-1865*” was published posthumously in October 2023. Bradbury died on June 11, 2023, at his home in Rolla, Missouri.

Scope and Content Note:

Civil War Research

This series contains materials related to research conducted by John Bradbury on the American Civil War in the Ozarks. The focus of the research is on northwest Arkansas and southern Missouri.

The Arkansas subseries contains research correspondence, copies of contemporary newspaper articles, research notes, and copies of scholarly articles regarding the American Civil War in Arkansas with an emphasis on northwest Arkansas. The materials in this series are maintained in their original order, loosely arranged alphabetically by subject.

The Missouri subseries contains research correspondence, copies of contemporary newspaper and scholarly articles, and research notes regarding the American Civil War in Missouri with an emphasis on the Missouri Ozarks. A large amount of the research contains information on guerrilla warfare, such as jayhawkers, red legs, bushwhackers, pro-Union and pro-Confederacy. Of note are the articles and research files regarding counterguerrilla Union soldier, John Kelso and Burch and William Monks. Also included in this series is an original copy of the 1885 work *Gedichte von Albert Sigel* published by Adjutant General Albert's wife Rosa that was owned by

Sigel's granddaughter Rose Bremerman in folder 210. Albert was the brother of General Franz Sigel.

The Military Units subseries contains correspondence, research notes, unit histories, newspaper clippings, and photocopies of personal letters and military records relating to military units who served in Missouri during the Civil War. The subseries is arranged in alphabetical order by state.

The Resources subseries contains published and/or bound reference resource materials pertaining to the Civil War in Missouri and northern Arkansas. Many of the resources are transcriptions created by Bradbury of soldier letters from men who served in the Ozarks. Also included are copies, research notes, research correspondence, and indexes of military records from the National Archives (NARA) including official correspondence and quartermaster records. The subseries is arranged by topic.

Missouri Railroads

This series contains materials related to railroads in Missouri. Included are promotional materials, timetables, rules and regulations, historical research, and images for various railroads that went through Missouri. Some of those railroads include the St. Louis-San Francisco Railroad (Frisco), Ozark Short Line, Missouri Southern, and the Missouri Pacific Railroad. The subseries is arranged by railroad line.

Research

The Route 66 subseries contains historic photographs, photographs from the late 1980s thru mid-1990s taken by Bradbury, maps of locations/layout of buildings drawn by Bradbury, historic site surveys, newspaper articles, journal articles, maps, photographs, and tourist guides. The papers deal with Phelps, Pulaski, Laclede, Webster, Greene, and Jasper counties with the majority of the folders dealing with locations, highway realignment, and photographs for Phelps County. The subseries is arranged alphabetically by topic.

The Caves subseries contains maps, articles, and research correspondence concerning Missouri caves, mostly in Phelps and Pulaski counties. The subseries is arranged alphabetically by topic.

The Lumber and Tie Industry subseries contains articles, research correspondence, and copies of historical documents related to the lumber, tie hacking, and tie rafting industry in the Missouri Ozarks. Most of the materials pertain to areas around the Gasconade, Little Piney, Big Piney, Niangua, and Current rivers. Folders 419-421 contain research on sawmill owners and notable tie hackers in the Ozarks. The subseries is arranged alphabetically by topic.

The Rivers and Resorts subseries contains research correspondence, articles, maps, photographs, and copies of original documents regarding the history of Missouri rivers in the central Ozarks. The history is mostly focused on resorts and the tie hacking industry along the Gasconade, Current, Little Piney, and Big Piney rivers. There is also genealogical research and records for prominent families in the sawmill and tie hacking business including the Boone, Baldrige, and McDonald families. This subseries is arranged in alphabetical order by subject.

The People subseries contains research correspondence, articles, research notes, photographs, and photocopies related to individuals and families. Of note is the extensive research on Frank Farris, a politician from Crawford and Phelps Counties, who was accused of bribery and

influence peddling but was ultimately acquitted. Bradbury used much of this research for the article "Honorable Frank Farris: 'Making a Bad Idea Look Good, and a Good One Better,'" *Phelps County Historical Society Newsletter* (October 2004,) cowritten with Lynn Morrow. This subseries is arranged in alphabetical order by subject.

The Archaeology and Relic Hunting subseries contains site reports submitted by Bradbury to the Archaeological Survey of Missouri regarding locations he investigated mostly in Phelps and Pulaski counties. The reports include correspondence, written descriptions of sites and finds, and sometimes maps of the surveyed areas. Note some of the folders are restricted.

The Subject Files subseries contains materials collected by Bradbury either for use in other research projects or because of their historical research potential. The subseries contains maps, photographs, articles, and original documents on a variety of Missouri topics and events, such as transportation, Trail of Tears, and life in the Ozarks.. The subseries is arranged in alphabetical order.

County Files

This series contains research files organized by Missouri county. The research topics range from genealogy, Civil War history, local history, Route 66, mining, and river recreation. The subseries contains original promotional materials, newspaper articles, research notes, photographs, promotional booklets, and maps. The subseries includes Crawford County, Dent County, Greene County, Iron County, Jasper County, Laclede County, Maries County, Reynolds County, Taney County, and Texas County.

The Phelps County subseries is the largest group with research spanning the entire county. Topics of interest include information about the county's early settlers, industry, and businesses. Of note in folder 654 is the autobiography of Lenore Jones Morris, who wrote about growing up in Jerome where her family ran the Oak Grove Cottages, the first highway bridge over the Gasconade, the effects of World War II, marrying John Morris and working at his grandfather's store (Scott Drug Store), and her time as the Queen of Love and Beauty for the university's St. Pat's celebration an honor she shared with her mother-in-law, Olive (Scott) Morris. The series is arranged alphabetically by subject.

The Pulaski County subseries contains research notes, articles, photographs, and information on the river resorts, Route 66, Fort Leonard Wood, and Civil War activities in the county.

The Texas County subseries contains research notes, articles, photographs, and information on local history. Of note in folder 775 is the oral history interview with a Mrs. Pittman in 1969, where she talks about the killing of the Parson's family and the execution of Jodie Hamilton. Included on the recording are songs said to have been sung by Hamilton at his hanging and songs written about the event.

Correspondence

This series contains correspondence between John Bradbury and other archivists, historians, and co-authors from various research and publication projects. The series is arranged in alphabetical order by correspondent surname.

Writings and Publications

This series contains the personal writings and publications of John F. Bradbury Jr., mostly regarding his Civil War research. Also included are research notes, drafts, and research correspondence regarding his book publications. Those books include, *A History of Southern Missouri and Northern Arkansas: Being an Account of the Early Settlements, the Civil War, the Ku-Klux, and Times of Peace* and “*My Own Commander: The Civil War Journal of J. J. Sitton, 1863-1865*.” The series is arranged by project or publication.

Publications

The Political Publications series contains booklets and pamphlets collected by Bradbury. The publications deal with political theories and systems, economic systems, and political rhetoric of the 1920s, 1930s, and 1940s.

The Publications subseries contains an assortment of publications collected by Bradbury over the years, many with military or Ozark subject matters. Of note is a signed copy of Pearl Spurlock’s “Over the Old Ozark Trails in the Shepherd of the Hills Country,” from 1939.

Photographs

The Photographs series contains images, originals and copies, collected by Bradbury pertaining to his interest in local history, the Civil War, Route 66, rivers and resorts, caves, railroads, and mining activities in Missouri. The series is arranged by subject and/or location.

The Slides subseries contains copies of images Bradbury used for presentations or in his numerous publications. The slides have been maintained how Bradbury organized them, mostly by topic or location.

Audio Visual

This series is organized by storage medium type, CDs, DVDs, and VHS tapes. Each subseries contains copies of photographs, presentations, oral history interviews, and home video recordings. Subject matters range from images of local businesses, towns, street scenes, events, railroad, and Route 66.

Oversize
