The collection contains family letters, voting lists for Ray County, Missouri, precinct committeemen, numerous bills and receipt, subscription lists for Liberty Loans, by-laws for the Richmond Civic League, newspaper clippings of the marriage of Robert Brady, prohibition campaign expense lists and political propaganda, Richmond Conservator Extra, a letter from Joseph A. Serena of William Woods College concerning precautions taken during the influenza epidemic, and two account books from the Bradys' business.
