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**Historical Note:**

Rev. Charles W. Clark was born in 1831 and was the minister of the Congregational Church in Georgia, Vermont. He married Harriet Colton in 1861. The couple had a son, Rev. William C. Clark who lived in Barnet. Rev. Charles W. Clark died in Georgia, in 1917.
