Historical Note:

M. Slade Kendrick was born in Mendon, Missouri, to Henry and Katherine Kendrick. He attended the University of Missouri and received his master's and Ph.D. degrees from Cornell University.

Arrangement:

The letters have been arranged chronologically.

Scope and Content Note:

John G. Neihardt and M. Slade Kendrick were close friends for over twenty years. This collection contains letters written by Neihardt to Kendrick from 1951, when the two were first introduced, to 1973, the year of Neihardt's death. Neihardt's deep feeling of friendship for Kendrick is unabashedly exhibited in the correspondence. He also presents his thoughts about his work, teaching, and family and friends. The collection also contains a map drawn by Neihardt of the Battle of the Little Big Horn and a six page manuscript describing a religious ceremony—the Sioux Prayer Garden. These items are located in folder 9 with a typescript by Kendrick, "Letters of John Neihardt to a Friend, and Selections From His Writings," n.d.
