Biographical Note:

William Clark was born in Virginia on August 1, 1770. He was a soldier, explorer, and a politician. In 1803, Clark, along with Meriwether Lewis, explored the new territory of the Louisiana Purchase. He became territorial governor of Missouri in 1813. Clark died in St. Louis on September 1, 1838.
