the Missouri State Teachers College, and a few items in the collection are attributed to him. David Lynch died on May 15, 1865, in Texas County, Missouri.

*The Scholar's Arithmetic: Or, Federal Accountant*, was written by Daniel Adams, a physician, textbook author, and state legislator. He wrote the *Scholar's Arithmetic* in 1801.
