Joseph Frizel opened his general merchandise store in Jackson, Missouri in 1817. He was backed by a St. Louis, Missouri trader. By 1820, he was having trouble collecting the debts on his merchandise, and in turn had trouble paying his own debts. The general merchandise store was dissolved by 1821.
