#### **Biographical Note:**

George Funkhouser was born in Virginia on September 16, 1814. He started a mercantile business in Maysville, Missouri, in the early 1850s and in 1855 moved to Plattsburg to start a

store. He was in business with his brother Abraham until the beginning of the Civil War. He was elected sheriff in 1865. He died on December 14, 1903.

#### Ledger

The series includes one ledger for 1860, portions of which have been covered over with invoices, 1872-1875, of C.W. Shepherd and Brothers, Plattsburg, Missouri, a general merchandise firm. The ledger book was used by both the Funkhouser brothers and the Shepherd brothers for accounting purposes, both of Plattsburg, Missouri.
