### **Biographical Note:**

John Morgan McMichael was born in 1838 in Ohio. He was the oldest of eight children of Hannah Morgan (1811-1881) and Thomas McMichael (1810-1890). When he was a baby, the family moved to Plattsburg, Missouri.

He was a student, clerk, merchant, politician and lawyer. Then in the 1870s he got into newspaper publishing. He started as the editor of the Daily Evening News in Kansas City. Then he started the Lever in Plattsburg, which published from about 1873-1883. After moving to Colorado for a number of years, he returned to Plattsburg and started the Plattsburg Leader, which ran from 1895-1990.

In 1864 he married Julia Lincoln (1845-1931), and they had six children. He died on June 6, 1905.
