**Biographical Note:**

Clair V. Mann, professor of civil engineering at the University of Missouri-Rolla for many years, was born June 3, 1884, in Reserville, Kansas, and died November 30, 1974, in Rolla. He was interested in history, wrote many articles of a historical nature, and served as historian for the Phelps County Historical Society until his death.

Mann was Phelps County highway engineer and county surveyor, a leader in legislative efforts to form the Missouri State Land survey authority, and developed objective tests for engineering students which were adopted by many colleges.
