#### INTRODUCTION

The papers contain one letter to French Glascock, Upperville, Loudoun County, Virginia, from New London, Ralls County, Missouri, August 10, 1823. The letter mentions the duel fought between Thomas C. Rector, brother of William V. Rector, and Joshua Barton, brother of David Barton, U.S. senator from Missouri. Letter also describes an epidemic of typhus that occurred in New London that summer.
