BIOGRAPHICAL

J. C. Whitten was born to Albert and Viola W. Whitten in Augusta, Maine, on September 14, 1866. He received a B.S. from the Agricultural College of South Dakota in 1892. He received his Ph.D. from the University of Halle in 1902. He was professor of Horticulture at the University of Missouri. He died June 5, 1922
