Historical Note:

In January 1968, the City Council passed a fair housing ordinance to be voted on by the citizens of Columbia, Missouri. The ordinance was designed to ban discriminatory practices in housing. The ordinance failed to pass by 812 votes on March 19, 1968. The following month, President Lyndon Johnson enacted the federal Fair Housing Act of 1968.

Arrangement:

The collection has been arranged by type of material.

Scope and Content Note:

The collection contains newspaper clippings, along with correspondence and miscellaneous material pertaining to the fair housing ordinance that was voted on in Columbia, Missouri, in March 1968. The collection also includes a video created by the City of Columbia for the 50th anniversary of the enactment of the federal Fair Housing Act on April 11, 1968.
