September 1967 marked the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the admission of women to the University of Missouri. A 27 member committee, appointed by Chancellor John W. Schwada and led by Dr. Lois Knowles, was created to help coordinate special activities for the 1967-1968 centennial year.

#### Records

The Records series includes correspondence, committee records, information on Centennial events, programs and press releases, photographs, and miscellaneous newspaper clippings.

# **Scrapbooks**

The Scrapbook series was created by Betty Cook Rottmann and was originally contained within three separate binders. The information in the binders was put in file folders in their original order. This series consists of historical articles, newspaper clippings, photographs, programs and speeches, and documents describing some of the events and activities of the centennial celebration.
