## BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Horace E. Slusher was president of the Missouri Farm Bureau Federation from 1944-1958, and was a member of the board of directors of the American Farm Bureau Federation and of the U.S. Chamber of Commerce. He also served on the Board of Visitors of the University.

Mr. Slusher was a lifelong Lexington area resident. He was a member of the Lexington First Christian Church and served on the church's board of directors. He was a member of the Rotary Club and Masonic Lodge.
