| f. 3 | Letters of Euclid to his mother, Dolly Beauchamp, from Galveston, Texas. Describes land, operation of his lumber mill, mule and cattle markets, necessity of selling mill, collection of debts, slave prices. |
| f. 4 | Death of Dolly Beauchamp and settlement of her estate, family news and business, post-Civil War conditions; death of Euclid Beauchamp's wife; short account of the circumstances of Euclid's family during the Civil War. |
| f. 5-6 | Correspondence, 1871-1894 |
| f. 5 | Family news of health, deaths, etc. Euclid's efforts to obtain education for Edwin and Clara Beauchamp. Edwin's failure in school. |
| f. 6 | Letters of Henrietta Dunlap and her family in Paris, Tennessee, to John Beauchamp in Liberty, Missouri, containing miscellaneous family news. |
