Biographical Note:

Sallie Hoskins was born in Tennessee on May 25, 1887. She married Daniel Halstead Frost and the couple and lived in Clinton, Missouri. Daniel Frost died in 1934. Sallie Frost later lived in

Columbia, Missouri. She died in Augusta, Georgia, on November 16, 1982, and is buried in Plattsburg, Missouri.
