Historical Note:

The Perche Church was organized as the Arm of Bethlehem Church in April 1874. Meetings were held on the second Sunday of each month in the Robinson School House with Green Cary as the first pastor. The name Perche Church was adopted in October 1880 when the church voted to accept the articles of faith of the New Hampshire Baptist Convention. Members at that time included Emelia Black, J.A. Carr, G.W. Gulick, Permelea E. Gulick, Mary E. Hombs, Emily Lyon, J.B. Lyon, Nancy E. Prowell, William Prowell, James W. Robinson, John Robinson, Sallie Robinson, Amanda Smith, Henson Smith, Susan Smith, Elizabeth Tisdale, and Woodson Tisdale.
