Historical Note:

This organization evolved from a committee of the Columbia, Missouri, chapter of People-to-People. It was connected to the national town affiliation program of the American Municipal Association. Paul Gwin chaired the Sister City steering committee of the Columbia Chapter of People-to-People. The city of Armenia in Columbia, South American, was selected as the sister city and the mayor of Armenia accepted affiliation in November 1964.
