#### **Biographical Note:**

Jubal Anderson Early was born on November 3, 1816, to Joab and Ruth (Hairston) Early. He served as a Lieutenant General for the Confederate Army during the American Civil War. After the war he worked as a lawyer. He died on March 2, 1894.
