INTRODUCTION

Records of the Church of Christ, Hallsville, Boone County, Missouri. The documents in the collection include information about baptisms, marriages, funerals, expenses, visiting preachers, and dismissals. The records of the Church of Christ pertain to business meetings, church proceedings, and membership lists. The records are incomplete because of large gaps in the material. The records are photocopies from the Liberty Church volumes. Leaders of the Church of Christ have re-numbered the pages to fit their records organization.

The records were donated to the State Historical Society of Missouri by J. P. Herring in December 1976 (Accession No. 2049).

ORGANZATIONAL SKETCH

The Church of Christ at Hallsville was established in 1914 after a controversial separation from the Liberty Church of Hallsville, known as the Red Top Church. The split was the result of Liberty Church's refusal to allow instrumental music in the church.
