**Historical Note:**

The project began in collaboration with the Daniel Boone Regional Library's One Read community-wide reading program. The 2008 One Read book was Ivan Doig's *The Whistling Season*, a novel centered around the narrator's reminiscences of attending a one-room schoolhouse in rural Montana.

On September 19, 2008, eight interviews were conducted of individuals who attended one-room schoolhouses at the Daniel Boone Regional Library in Columbia, Missouri. Additional interviews have since been conducted and the collection is now an ongoing project of the State Historical Society of Missouri.

**Scope and Content Note:**

The One-room Schoolhouse Oral History Collection consists of oral history interviews digitally recorded and placed onto CDs for patron use and transcripts.

The **Interviews** series consists of CDs, some transcripts, and in some instances, interviewees have donated supporting biographical information such as photographs, written recollections, and other miscellanea. These materials are filed after the corresponding transcripts.

The **School Materials** series consists of lesson booklets, workbooks, and textbooks used at the Blades School outside of Republic, Missouri. The materials were donated by Bonita Pipkin (CD 21) and were used by her, her father, and her grandfather in a one-room school.
