## INTRODUCTION

The papers contain the research material and writings of Jonathan Kwitny, a Jewish American writer and investigative journalist.

## BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Jonathan Kwitny was born in Indianapolis on March 23, 1941, to Julia Goldberger Kwitny and Dr. I.J. Kwitny (president of the medical staff at St. Vincent Indianapolis Hospital), and graduated in 1962 from the University of Missouri's School of Journalism. He received a master's degree in history in 1964 at New York University. His newspaper career began as a reporter for *The Evening News* of Perth Amboy, New Jersey, between 1963 and 1969. He was a former front page feature writer for the *Wall Street Journal* producing front page columns and articles about national and international topics. Kwitny joined the *Journal* in 1971 and worked there for the next seventeen years. He stayed with *The Journal* until his move to PBS in 1988. He later worked for the Gannett Company guiding Trenton coverage for its New Jersey papers. He also served as a consultant for Pope John Paul II for *NBC Nightly News*. Kwitny also had in the 1980s a PBS series entitled *The Kwitny Report*, which during its four year run won the George Polk Award in 1990 for best investigative reporting on television.

Kwitny was the author of a number of non-fiction books. His fifth book, *Endless Enemies*, received a Pulitzer Prize nomination.

Jonathan Kwitny married Wendy Wood on September 4, 1993. His first wife, Martha Kaplan Kwitny, had previously died of long-term kidney disease at the age of 33. Kwitny devoted some years to completing his biography of Pope John Paul II, which he began in 1992. He died in 1998 of esophageal stomach cancer.

All of the material in the papers is directly related to or derived from Kwitny's investigative research. The papers have been arranged into the following nine series and five subseries:

NOTE: Please note that in an effort to maintain original order and file integrity, some of the series are listed more than once in the folder list. The papers are arranged in chronological order within each series, using the earliest date in the date ranges.

The **Criminal Activity** series includes material on individuals involved in criminal activity, including some members of organized crime. Some folders focus on locations. Also included is research on Teamsters-Unions, with numerous references with connections to organized crime, Jimmy Hoffa, and the trucker's union, longshoremen, etc. Lorimar-Telepictures, producers of the hit TV series *Dallas*, were investigated as to the executive director's possible involvement with organized crime, as well as investigations into the Rancho La Costa resort in Las Vegas, allegedly a known mob hangout.

The series also includes material concerning infiltration by organized crime into the mozzarella cheese and pizzeria industries on the east coast, as well as investigations into organized crime in the meatpacking, garment, and loan industries, and an investigation into charges of "payola" given to radio station DJs to play only "selected" music and to place them on the top hit lists. Information regarding general criminal activity in Teamsters, pension fund, loans, bonds, as well as organized crime's attempt to control toxic waste disposal in various companies, landfill probes, articles and court dockets is also included.

The **Correspondence, Speeches, Books, and Publishing** series includes Kwitny's discussion of his work with various colleagues, his correspondence with a number of American embassies in Asia and Africa inquiring as to the possibilities of work through international agencies in the 1960s. This material also includes some of Kwitny's speeches regarding developments in international affairs. There is also correspondence regarding some of Kwitny's writings and a copy of his unpublished book, "The Paper Tigers, The Criminals Who Run Economic Life in America." Frequent references are made to his well-publicized book, *Endless Enemies*. Much of the correspondence is in regard to contract wording.

The **Court Cases** series includes material regarding Love vs. Kwitny, a libel action in which the appellant Kennett Love claimed that appellee Jonathan Kwitny defamed him during the course of a speech he gave at a conference in 1989. Other material concerns the 1983 Ronald Rewald case, in which Ronald Rewald was tried and found guilty of defrauding a number of investors to his firm Bishop, Baldwin, Rewald, Dillingham and Wong, an investment firm based in Hawaii. The case also included CIA involvement in the firm and that Rewald had CIA connections. Also included in the series are some international cases, particularly in Italy.

The **Fraud** series concerns various forms of fraud, including the Central States Pension Fund fraud, where millions of dollars of membership money was being put into gambling casinos, bankrupt hotels, and other interests of organized crime in the 1970s. The series also contains a series of 1980 court cases involving Rockwell International Corporation, Space Transportation and Systems Group, in which the corporation was accused of perpetrating fraud in its contracts with NASA (National Aeronautics and Space Administration) in the 1980s.

In the **Africa** series, the extensive social, political and economic troubles in Angola and Kinshasa are explored by Kwitny during the 1970s-1980s.

The **Drugs and Gun Trafficking** series largely concerns Lebanon with material on several “sting” operations that were conducted. There are references to numerous individuals, including their arrests.

International events are covered in the **International** series. The bulk of this material includes the Soviet occupation of Afghanistan in the 1980s. Other areas covered are Iran and the Middle East; Jewish prosecution in the Ukraine (U.S.S.R.); the U.S. military presence in Nicaragua; the plot to assassinate the Pope; and the controversial incursions into Laos in Vietnam by a team of former soldiers under the leadership of James “Bo” Gritz, former U.S. Green Beret officer. The purpose of the incursions was to rescue American soldiers still believed to be held as prisoners. These events took place in the 1980s and 1990s.

The **Conspiracies and Mysteries** series concern’s Kwitny’s research regarding the conspiracy theories behind the assassination of John F. Kennedy and the role of Lee Harvey Oswald and the CIA. There is also a small amount of material which proposes the theory that famous aviator Amelia Earhart’s disappearance in 1937 may have been attributable to a map-maker’s error.

The **AIDS Drugs Controversy** series consists of research material concerning the AIDS drugs controversy and its impact on the gay community in the 1980sand 1990s.
