Biographical Note:

Irvine Woodrow Davis was born January 13, 1916, in Nelson, Missouri, to William Percy Davis and Bessie Woolery. Nona Myrom Davis was born in Nella, Arkansas, July 13, 1914, to John Wilburn Bell and Lorena Hildebrand. The couple married May 14, 1939, in Houstonia, Missouri.

They had one son, George, who died in infancy in 1940, and one daughter, Joyce Nadean Davis, born October 10, 1941. Nona was a school teacher, having received degrees from the Central Missouri State Teachers College and Missouri Valley College. She helped Irvine on their farm near Miami, Missouri, until they sold the farm and moved to Independence, Missouri, in 1959, where Irvine worked at the Leeds General Motors plant.

Joyce Davis attended public schools in Marshall, Missouri, and received her BA from William Jewell College. She also acquired degrees at Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary, University of North Carolina, and Duke University. Joyce held numerous positions in libraries throughout the country, ending her career as the Director of Library Services for Emporia State University in Kansas. She traveled to China several times to address the National Library of China in Beijing.
