#### INTRODUCTION

The Emily E. Evans Papers contain records collected from her time as a U.S. Army nurse during WWII, including newsletters and memoirs from her time serving abroad as well as her military records from 1943-1954. It also includes three scrapbooks containing miscellaneous military and 1940s ephemera, newspaper clippings, and photographs from her time spent in England, France and Switzerland. The scrapbooks were dismantled and put into folders in their original order.

#### BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

Emily E. Evans was born September 4, 1910, in St. Louis, Missouri, to S.D. Evans and Alma Loomis Evans. She attended Christian College in Columbia (now Columbia College) and received a nursing degree from the University of Missouri. She became an army nurse through the American Red Cross and entered the service in March of 1943, becoming a 1st lieutenant. She served until 1946. Evans was stationed in London, England, at the 16th Station hospital and worked on the surgical team. She was later transferred to the American Hospital Building (203rd Hospital) outside Reims, France. Evans died on June 11, 2004, at the age of 93 and is buried at the Jefferson Barracks National Cemetery in St. Louis.
