Biographical Note:

Henry W. Harper worked as a clerk alongside his uncle George B. Harper in a drugstore in Boonville, Missouri. He was born in Boonville on September 20, 1859. Harper married Susan Randolph West on July 9, 1895, and they had one son, Henry W. Harper, Jr. By 1900 the family

was living in Austin, Texas, and Harper was a professor of chemistry at the University of Texas. He died there on August 28, 1943.
