Dr. William Redmon was born in Kentucky and moved to Boone County with his family. He completed medical school in St. Charles and set up practice in Tipton, Missouri. Redmon married Sarah E. Howard and the couple had Squire Howard, William, Charles, Sarah, Mary, Rosanna and Nancy. Dr. William Redmon, with his son Squire, established a Jersey cattle business. His daughter, Mary, married Sylvester W. Hurst, a druggist and Missouri State Representative for Moniteau County. The business became Redmon and Hurst.
