Historical Note:

In 1950, churches in downtown Columbia, Missouri, created their own council in order to create a dialogue and plan larger services within the community, such as public holidays. By 1970, the

Columbia Council of Churches accepted the rabbi at the University of Missouri Hillel Jewish campus ministry and renamed itself the Interfaith Council. Shortly after, Unitarian and Baha'i leaders joined the council. Today the Interfaith Council is a coalition of faith communities, non-profit organizations, and government agencies.
