Biographical Note:

Allen P. Green (1875-1956) was born to Joseph Henry (1842-1910) and Eliza Homan McHenry Green (1842-1894) in Jefferson City alongside sisters Mabel (1869-1960) and Bessie (1871-1958). After briefly attending the University of Missouri School of Mines and Metallurgy in 1894, he worked as a city engineer before marrying Sarah “Josephine” Brown (1874-1957) of Dresden (Mo.) in 1903. They first lived in Saint Louis where A. P. worked for a refractory--raising children Elizabeth (1904-1986), Martha (1905-1987), Josephine (1907-1983), Robert (1909-1964), and Allen, Jr. (1909-1970)--before purchasing his own company in Mexico (Mo.) in 1910.

Through A. P. Green’s business, the family built a significant fortune and constructed a large estate in the area in 1931; there, they and their extended family continued to run the brick firm while meanwhile making charitable and philanthropic contributions to the surrounding area. Their eldest daughter Elizabeth married Arthur D. Bond (1902-1983) in 1930, with whom she had two sons--Arthur, Jr. (1933-2017), and Christopher “Kit” (1939-) Bond. Much of this collection is related to A. P. Green and his wife Josephine as well as their daughter Elizabeth, son-in-law Arthur, and their grandson Kit who would later become a governor and U.S. Senator.

Scope and Content Note:

Green family

This series contains materials surrounding the community activities of A. P. Green and his wife Josephine; the former’s day books; and genealogical research and correspondence. There are also papers regarding their home in Mexico (Mo.) and details of their second house in Florida; travel writings (mostly by Josephine and her daughter Elizabeth); and several photographs. Arranged by category of material and then chronologically, 1928-1956.

Bond family

This series includes accolades presented to Arthur Bond and his son Christopher (“Kit”); correspondence from Arthur and Elizabeth during a trip to South America; schoolwork from Kit’s time at Deerfield Academy and Princeton University in the 1950s; and family photographs. Arranged by category of material and then chronologically, 1909-1993.

Oversize items

This series contains certificates and awards (e.g., diplomas); photographs; and architectural drawings and blueprints from the Green and Bond families. Of note are plans for the Green estate in Mexico (Mo.), items 23-30, by landscape architect John Noyes. Arranged by type of material and then chronologically.
