Biographical Note:

William Arthur Allee was born October 30, 1914, to William Arthur and Finis (White) Allee. He was a career professor, teaching at the University of Illinois, Champaign-Urbana, and the

University of Houston. Retiring in 1978, he began research and compiling genealogical materials on the Allee/Alley family. He died on March 4, 2008.

David Allee (1762-1835), the son of Nicholas Allee (1740-1808), moved from Kentucky to Moniteau County, Missouri, sometime in the early 1800s. The family cemetery, the Allee Cemetery, is located in California, Missouri.

Scope and Content Note:

Family Group Records

This series contains family group record sheets for members of the Allee and Alley family. Arthur, the donor, sorted the collection into individual files for family members that also contain records for their immediate descendants. These records contain information on family members from the early 1700s to the mid-1900s. Included in some of the folders are additional written histories of the family members. Folders have been combined but the series has been left in its original order. The final folder in the series contains lose record sheets that were found in the collection. Birth and death dates have been provided on the folder titles to assist researchers in identification.

Research Materials

This series contains correspondence, legal records, a photograph, newspaper clippings, and miscellaneous research compiled by Allee. The bulk of the correspondence is between Allee and distant family members and genealogists sharing research information on the Allee/Alley family. The legal records are typescript and photocopied wills from family members. The newspaper clippings are of articles discussing members of the Allee/Alley family. Lastly, the miscellaneous research material is comprised of handwritten notes, typed lists, and photocopied pages from genealogical and county history books. This series has been arranged by type of material.
