Historical Note:

The Muleskinners, a Democratic party support group, was started in 1974 by Harold Riback as a way for local democrats not associated with the Central Committee to meet and promote the

party. The group originally met monthly at the former Tiger Hotel, where the members would have lunch and listen to a speaker. One of the first Muleskinner presidents was Warren Welliver, who later became a State Senator and Missouri Supreme Court judge. Other early members included former State Representatives Bob Smith, Larry Woods, and Margot Patterson, and former State Senator Vanlandingham.

The early Muleskinners contributed to the successful election of Democratic county officials in 1976 and 1978 including Richard Farmer, Roger Wilson, Kay Murray, Joe Mosely, Bettie Johnson, and Chris Kelly. After the death of Harold Riback, the Muleskinners became less active until they stopped meeting in 1979.

In 1983, the Muleskinners were revived through the combined efforts of Boone County Democrats and local elected officials including Chris Kelly, Ken Jacob, Wendy Noren, Viva Spier, Norma Robb, and Hazel Riback. They host forums that highlight Democratic candidates for office. In addition, programming focuses on providing relevant information on government, public administration, and public policy. Over the years, it has been commonplace for Boone County's Democratic candidates to announce their candidacies at Muleskinner meetings.
