Historical Note

In 2013 the 97th Missouri General Assembly issued House Concurrent Resolution 7 (HCR7) tasking the State Historical Society of Missouri to develop "plans, ideas, and proposals to commemorate and celebrate" the Missouri Bicentennial and to provide "guidance and direction to a statewide effort to promote and celebrate the State of Missouri's rich and complex history."

On October 12, 2018, Governor Michael L. Parson signed Executive Order 18-07 creating the Missouri Bicentennial Commission. The purpose of the Commission is to "aid the State Historical Society of Missouri in its charge to plan for and implement the commemoration of the Missouri bicentennial and to further state efforts to honor the State of Missouri and its rich history and heritage on the occasion of its bicentennial."

Under the Missouri 2021 banner, SHSMO coordinated a statewide commemoration that incorporated both rural and urban communities in projects, programs, and events that contributed to a better shared understanding of the State's geographic and cultural diversity as well as the similarities that bring us together as Missourians.
