INTRODUCTION

A Boonville photographer, Maximilian Schmidt's photographs consist of glass plate negatives and prints from ca. 1895-1932. Schmidt captured his family, and Boonville inhabitants and their environs including early Missouri River floods, steamboats and ferries, views of Boonville streets and the riverfront area, Chouteau Springs, and the Kemper Family School buildings and students.

BIOGRAPHICALSKETCH

Maximilian E. Schmidt was born in Peru, Illinois, on April 19, 1865 of German immigrant parents, Albin and Caroline Schmidt. Schmidt had several brothers and sisters who remained in the Peru area, and one brother, Frederick, who lived in Detroit. Trained as a watchmaker and jeweler, Maximilian received his education in that trade in La Salle, Illinois; St. Paul, Minnesota; and Fon Du Lac, Wisconsin. After working in the jewelry business for three years in Chillicothe, Schmidt moved to Boonville, where he became a junior partner in his father-in-law's store, Gmelich and Huber Jewelry Company, in 1893. Two years later, E. J. Garr, who had made Schmidt's acquaintance in Chillicothe, moved to Boonville and worked as a jeweler at Gmelich and Schmidt for more than forty years. In 1905, E. G. Huber sold his portion of the firm to Schmidt, and the store became known as Gmelich and Schmidt. Schmidt became the sole proprietor after the death of his father-in-law in 1914. Another employee, John Hoefer, joined the business in 1916 at the age of sixteen. After Schmidt's death on September 20, 1932, his son, Albin Jacob, operated the family business.

Schmidt married Louise "Lulu" Gmelich, the daughter of Jacob F. and Doris Mueller Gmelich, in June 1889. The Gmelichs had adopted Louise after she was orphaned by the death of her father, Emil Mueller, Mrs. Schmidt's brother. The Schmidts had three children: Albin Jacob, Doris Eugenie, and Maximilian Gmelich, Jr. Albin Jacob was born in Boonville in 1892 and married Beulah "Totsy" Randolph, daughter of C. L. and Eva Randolph of 712 E. High Street, Boonville, in September 1916. They had two children: Randolph (b. 1918) and Gertrude (b. 1919).Born in Boonville in 1894, Doris married Boonville native Alexander H. Stephens, Jr., in January 1919. They had two children: a daughter, born in 1920, and a son, born in 1923. Maximilian Schmidt, Jr., was born March 20, 1909. A graduate of the U.S. Naval Academy, he was killed during World War II while commanding the submarine *USS Scorpion*.

Schmidt's father-in-law, Jacob Gmelich, emigrated from Germany with his parents in 1851 at the age of twelve. After a short stay in Ohio they moved to Peru, Illinois, where many of Gmelich's brothers and sisters remained. Gmelich opened his jewelry business in Boonville in 1861 in a log building on Main Street, later moving his business to its permanent location at 309 Main Street. Gmelich served as mayor of Boonville for eight years (1876-1882 and 1884-1886) during a time when that duty included acting as police judge. He became prominent in Republican Party politics and ran as a candidate for state treasurer in 1896.In 1904 he was elected to that office, serving from January 1905 to January 1909. Gmelich was appointed to the University of

Missouri board of curators in 1899 and elected as a delegate to the Republican National Convention in 1900. After winning a close election, he became lieutenant governor of Missouri under Herbert L. Hadley (January 1909 to January 1913). The Gmelichs lived in a three-story brick home on High Street in Boonville for twenty-eight years before moving to Jefferson City in 1904. After Gmelich returned to Boonville, he began building a new home that was only partially completed when he died in February 1914. Fire destroyed the home in 1917. Gmelich was a member of the Evangelical Church in Boonville, and his wife, Doris, gave an organ in his honor to the church in 1915.

Schmidt took up photography around 1896 "as a recreation for out door life." During his lifetime, he received awards for his photographs, including a second-place medal at the Louisiana Purchase Exposition of 1904. Apart from his hobby of photography and his occupation as a jeweler, Schmidt played an active role in the Boonville community. He served as treasurer on the board of the Missouri Training School for Boys from 1909 to 1912 and on the Boonville school board from 1913 to 1919. He was secretary on the first board of public works established in 1919. He belonged to the Boonville Episcopal Church and was a member of the Ancient Free and Accepted Masons, Knights Templar, Ararat Temple of Mystic Shriners of Kansas City, and Woodmen of the World. Schmidt helped organized the Boonville Country Club and was an enthusiastic golfer.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE

The collection includes photographs, primarily glass plate negatives, taken by Maximilian E. Schmidt. The bulk of the images depict Boonville and surrounding Cooper County at the turn of the 20^{th} century. Beyond Missouri, the collection includes photographs of Peru, Illinois, and Detroit and Lake St. Clair, Michigan.

Glass negatives are arranged by size. The majority of the negatives date from 1897 to 1920 and have been tentatively dated by the processor. Film negatives and paper prints are arranged by identifier. Prints corresponding to glass negatives are numbered with the same identifier. Prints include materials from Schmidt as well as prints made at a later date.

Each negative has been assigned an identifier (SHS no.) consisting of a letter that indicates the size of the negative (A=5x7, B=4x5, C=3x3, and D=8x10 and 5x8) and a number that shows a particular negative's location among negatives of the same size (e.g., A175 is the 175th negative of the 5x7 negatives). The number is written on the lower right-hand corner of each negative.

Within each size, the negatives have been organized primarily into two sections: images of Cooper County and Biographical, or portrait, images. Identification of the photos comes from a variety of sources. Schmidt identified some on scraps of paper found in the negative boxes. He wrote directly on several negatives in a crayon marking pencil, and these marks have not been removed. Robert L. Dyer of Boonville identified some images prior to their donation to the Society. The processor has tentatively identified other images using resources such as Dyer's *Boonville: An Illustrated History*, and *Boonville: The Vine-Clad City* by Boonville photographer Frank Truby.

Use copies are available through the Society's digital collections for all formats. The glass plate negatives are also duplicated on microfilm.
