Historical Note:

The *Missouri Ruralist* magazine began as *The Ruralist* in 1901 and initially published out of Sedalia, Missouri. The title changed to *Missouri Ruralist* in 1910. The periodical circulated news on “the interests of agriculture, horticulture, stock-raising and kindred industries,” with a particular focus on Missouri farms, farmers, and families. Cordell W. Tindall (1914-2002) was editor of the *Missouri Ruralist* from 1938 through his retirement in 1979. He was succeeded by Larry S. Harper (1942-2005), who was editor from 1976-1999.

Scope and Content Note:

The photos document the increased industrialization of farming, use of pesticides and herbicides, agricultural extension programs, veterans farm training, 4-H, Future Farmers of America, the Missouri State Fair, farm demonstrations and sales, local fairs and festivals, and new, innovative farming techniques. Caption information from publication in the *Missouri Ruralist* identify many of the people and locations in the photos.
