Abstract: The Louise Wilder Smith Tierney Papers consist of a newspaper clipping, press release, scripts, and a program for the pageant "Fort Osage-Mother of the West," written by Louise Smith and performed at Fort Osage in Sibley, Missouri, on June 22 through June 27, 1953.

Historical Note:

Louise Wilder Smith was born on May 13, 1910. No historical information could be found pertaining to her early life. She married William L. Tierney on May 25, 1917, in Kansas City, Missouri. During the 1950s, she entered into a pageant-writing contest on the topic of celebrating and depicting pioneer life during the early days of Fort Osage, Missouri. Smith's entry, "Fort-Osage-Mother of the West," won the competition and was performed before an audience on June 22 through June 27, 1953. No additional historical information could be found.
