Historical Note:

Kansas City Power and Light Company, at the request of Armour and Company, conducted an analysis of the steam and electric requirements at the Armour plant in Kansas City, Kansas, for the period June 6, 1942, through June 5, 1943, to determine the energy used and the feasibility of a “purchased services plan” to meet those energy needs. The report was completed and presented to Armour and Company September 16, 1946.

Arrangement:

Scope and Content Note:

The collection contains a single bound volume, related to energy consumption by the Armour and Company plant located at 18 Central Avenue, Kansas City, Kansas. The volume includes correspondence concerning the report and recommendations suggested prior to the study. The volume’s appendix contains drawings and maps used in development of the study.
