These records consist of minutes and agenda of the MACEA executive council for the period October 2, 1978 through March 12, 1979 and include material related to the legislative interests of the group at that time. There are letters related to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission and H.R.10785 for the appropriation of funds for public participation and a form letter sent to members of Congress in August 1978.

These records also contain news releases of MACEA and other environmental organizations for the period 1973-1980; newsletters for MACEA for the period 1973-1981; and flyers distributed to members of the organization. The collection also includes other material, published and unpublished, related to energy questions.

Provenance

These records were received as accession KA0085 on May 27, 1981, from Bill Rousch of the MidAmerican Coalition for Energy Alternatives under the terms of a contract signed November 20, 1980.

Institutional Sketch

The MidAmerican Coalition for Energy Alternatives (MACEA) was a regional organization formed in about 1973 to serve as a citizen action and lobbying group in support of renewable energy resources. The group was active in its opposition to nuclear power plants, especially the Wolf Creek Power Plant. It also served as a lobby group in legislative chambers and Public Service Commission hearings on energy issues and utility rate structures.
