Introduction

The collection contains a single microfilm reel containing two volumes of marriages conducted by Albert Victor Hart in the cities of Princeton, Raytown, and Hannibal, Missouri, between 1941 and 1960. An index is included in each volume.

Albert Victor Hart was born on January 7, 1884, in Ealing, England. Hart became a naturalized citizen of the United States while living in Pennsylvania on February 6, 1905. Hart was a graduate of Drake University, Des Moines, Iowa, and was a member of the Hopkins Christian Church. Hart worked as a minister and began sanctify marriages in Missouri, Iowa, and Kansas. Hart married Nellie Valentine Grable (1890-1957) on June 17, 1913. Hart died on March 3, 1962, in Maryville, Missouri, and is buried at the Hopkins Cemetery.
