The collection consists of a single reel of microfilm containing Andrew County, Missouri, Justice of the Peace, J. P. Burns' Criminal Dockets between 1936 and 1939. Each record includes the names of the defendant, the charge, notes on the facts pertaining to each case, and the disposition for the case. An index of defendant's names included.

J. P. Burns served as the Justice of the Peace for Savannah, Missouri, located in Andrew County between 1936 and 1939.
