Dr. Logan Wood, a physician in Bolckow, Andrew County, Missouri, compiled these records at least as early as the 1930s. Eugene L. Wood gave the records to the Andrew County Historical Society.

The Andrew County Historical Society loaned these records to the State Historical Society of Missouri Manuscripts so they could be microfilmed and made available for research. They were received as accession 0331kc on November 16, 1985. The originals have been returned to the Andrew County Historical Society for permanent preservation.
