The collection consists of newspaper clippings, audio-visual materials, correspondence, artifacts, magazines, photographs, posters, and other ephemera pertaining to the television and circus career of Frank Oliver Wiziarde, who portrayed Whizzo the Clown in the Kansas City metropolitan area. Additional materials include genealogical documents related to the Wiziarde family and family photographs.

Frank Oliver "Whizzo" Wiziarde was born on July 25, 1916, in Westmoreland, Kansas, to circus performers, Jack Oliver and Laura Lulu Baldwin Wiziarde. He performed with his family in the Wiziarde Trio, and later the Wiziarde Novelty Circus. From 1942 until 1946, Wiziarde served in the United States Army during World War II. After the war, Wiziarde became a radio announcer for KFEQ in St. Joseph, Missouri.

Wiziarde debuted his television personality, "Whizzo the Clown," with KMBC-TV in 1953 and program aired in 1954. The "Whizzo" character would be featured on KCMO-TV in Kansas City and then later WIBW-TV in Topeka, Kansas. The last airing of "Whizzo" took place on May 20, 1987.

Wiziarde married Kitty Louise Handley. He died on September 11, 1987, in Johnson County, Kansas, and is buried at the Johnson County Chapel and Memorial Gardens in Overland Park, Kansas.
