Abstract: The collection consists of the records of the Leawood Women's Club of Leawood, Kansas. Materials primarily consist of annual reports from the board, meeting minutes, chapter yearbooks, event flyers, and a small selection of photographs and negatives. The bulk of the collection consists of scrapbooks documenting the activities of the organization.

Historical Note:

The Leawood Women's Club was formed in 1960 by Betty Frier and Martha Segrist. The goal of the club was to promote sociability, culture, and welfare within Leawood, Kansas. Membership for the organization was open to all women of Leawood. The club raised funds for charitable organizations through cultural and educational events. In May 2018, the organization celebrated its 58th anniversary.

Scope and Content Note:

Organizational Records

This series contains the organizational records related to the Leawood Women's Club. The bulk of this series consists of annual reports from the various board members of the organization along with meeting minutes. In addition, this series contains bylaws, club yearbooks, newsletters, and event flyers.

Visual Materials

This series consists of photographs and negatives depicting events that the Leawood Women's Club held throughout the years. When possible, these events have been identified.

Oversize

This series contains scrapbooks documenting the yearly activities of the organization. The scrapbooks span the club's existence and contain newspaper clippings, photographs of members and events, event flyers, and memorabilia. Volumes 13 and 14 had bulk loose photographs in the front; these were removed, sleeved, and put behind the scrapbook in the same folder.
