The collection consists of research materials, correspondence, meeting minutes, notes, and other materials related to Samuel A. Montague's involvement in public relations, fundraising campaigns, and organizations in the Kansas City metropolitan area. Additional materials include issues of the *KC Downtown* magazine with Montague as the publisher.

Samuel Alfred Montague was born on May 30, 1912, in New Orleans, Louisiana. Montague graduated from the University of Missouri School of Journalism. After graduation, he worked as a marketing and communications professional in the Kansas City metropolitan area. He served as a lieutenant colonel in the United States Air Force during World War II and the Korean War.

Montague was heavily involved in several civic campaigns and fundraisers. He was the director for the earnings tax and airport bonds elections and instrumental in establishing People to People International and creating the Kansas City Tourist Commission. Montague also assisted in fundraising efforts for Truman Medical Center, Pershing Memorial Museum, and the Gillis Home for Children. He was a member of the Public Relations Society of America, the American Association of Fund-Raising Council, and the National Writers Club.

Montague died on May 13, 2015, and is buried at Fort Leavenworth National Cemetery in Fort Leavenworth, Kansas.
